“Clifford the Big Red Dog”, The Cinema, Lymington Community Centre, New Street, Lymington SO41 9BQ.

Scarf are having a private viewing of the film “Clifford the Big Red Dog” (PG) at the Cinema in Lymington. Suitable for children age 3+ for the ringos, and 6+ for the ski bobs. All children will need to wear helmets during the session which can be borrowed, or you can bring your own (cycling or skiing helmets are fine).

This is wheelchair accessible along the promenade. There are plenty of cafes along the way, and the plan is to stop for a hot chocolate/tea/coffee at some point during the walk. There is no charge for this activity, but please let us know if you’re planning on coming so we can look out for you. We’ll send some reminders out a bit nearer the time too. **No Charge, but please let us know if you’re coming.**

- **We will hold a waiting list for over-subscribed activities – we’ll let you know if you’re on this list. You won’t need to pay for this activity unless a place becomes available.**
