**Tues 28<sup>th</sup> May, 10am-1pm**

**Fishing with Fun2Fish, Orchard Lakes, New Lane, Bashley, BH25 5TD**

12 places are available for a morning of fishing with Bob from Fun2Fish. Children need to be 8 years and over, however if you have a slightly younger child please let us know as we may be able to help out. Siblings over 8 years are welcome to join in too, but Bob has asked that young/pre-school siblings don't attend if at all possible due to the water. All tackle is provided – please do not bring your own gear as Fun2Fish are only insured to use theirs. Please bring a packed lunch with you. Tea, coffee and snacks hopefully will be available to buy on site (fingers crossed).

**Tues 28<sup>th</sup> May, 10.30am-12pm**

**Animal Assisted Therapy with Sarah May, Ashley, New Milton, Hants**

We have booked 2 sessions with Sarah over May Half Term (the other session is on Thurs 30<sup>th</sup> May), as there is always a demand for this activity. Children can enjoy spending quality time with Sarah's pets, which include Finley the spaniel (an approved assisted therapy dog), guinea pigs, rabbits and chickens. This will take place outside in Sarah's garden (which has shelter if it rains) and families can spend time meeting and petting the animals in small groups of 6 children. **Tues 28<sup>th</sup> May, 6-7.30pm (arrive from 5.45pm)**

**Adventure Golf at Lymington Golf Course, South Baddesley Road, Lymington, SO41 5SD**

We will have the adventure golf course available just for Scarf families from 6pm (please arrive between 5.45pm and 6pm so we can stagger start times). The course is a fun, 18 hole mini adventure golf course, built with children in mind, but entertaining for adults too! There are lots of features of the New Forest to look out for as you move around the course, including the ferry from Lymington to the Isle of Wight! The course takes roughly 1 to 1½ hours to go around. Parents/carers must remain with their children around the course, whether you play with them or watch. Usually there are 4 players per hole – we will keep families in groups, or put families

together where appropriate. There is a small kiosk where you can buy drinks, crisps and ice creams, but no room for families to have picnics. **Wed 29<sup>th</sup> May, 1.30-4.30pm (arrive 1.15am)**

**Climbing & Archery, Tile Barn, Church Lane, Brockenhurst, SO42 7UB**

A chance to have a go at a couple of different activities at Tile Barn Activity Centre in Brockenhurst. Children/young people will start with a session on the climbing wall (a couple will climb at a time, with the rest helping with the ropes) and also archery. Each activity lasts 1½ hours, with a short break in between. Please bring along any drinks/snacks that you need during the session. We have 12 spaces available for children/young people from **6 years upwards**.

**£10 per child (12 spaces for children age 6+)**

**Thurs 30<sup>th</sup> May, All day (we can book a different day for you if it clashes with another Scarf activity you are keen to do!)**

**Beaulieu Motor Museum, Beaulieu, Hampshire, SO42 7ZN**

Enjoy a family day out at the Beaulieu Motor Museum – hopefully bump into other Scarf families along the way! There's lots of different cars to see from over the years – “from legendary F1 cars and land speed record breakers for the speed freaks, to incredible examples of pioneering motoring for the history-buffs”! There's also the adventure playground to run off steam, and the monorail/skytrain to try out, amongst all the other things to see and do. Tickets give you access to The National Motor Museum, World of Top Gear, Palace House & Gardens, Little Beaulieu (adventure playground), Beaulieu Abbey, The Secret Army Exhibition and unlimited rides on the monorail.

**£5 per child (5-16) with SEN, £8 per adult with a disability (age 17+), £7 per child/sibling (5-16), Carers free, £14 extra adults and Under 5's free (proof required for disabled child/young person). Sorry so many different prices this time – just tell us who's coming and we can work it out!**

**Thurs 30<sup>th</sup> May, 10.30am-12pm**

**Animal Assisted Therapy with Sarah May, Ashley, New Milton, Hants**

This is our 2<sup>nd</sup> session with Sarah over May Half Term (the other session is on Tues 28<sup>th</sup> May) - see above for more details on this activity.

**£6 per child – 6 children**

**Thurs 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2-3pm (possible 2<sup>nd</sup> session if there's demand)**

**Printing/Painting Workshop with Milli, SpudWORKS, Station Rd, Sway, SO41 6BA**

Join artist, Milli, for a creative workshop – Milli will show children/young people how to design and paint their own T shirt (bring along a T shirt for this, or pillow case/cloth tote bag). You will also get the chance to try out some simple lino cuts and block printing onto paper and materials. Wear clothes that you don't mind getting a little paint on!

**£5 for 8 children, age 7+ (8 children max)**

**Fri 31<sup>st</sup> May, 9-10am**

**Soft-Play Zone, Ringwood Health and Leisure, Parsonage Barn Ln, Ringwood BH24 1PX**

We have a private booking, just for Scarf families, to experience Ringwood's four storey indoor soft play centre suitable for children up to age 12yrs (older children can take part during this session if they are keen and mindful of the little ones, and of course if they are in there assisting the younger ones). There are plenty of features to keep everyone entertained such as slides, spider webs, ball pits and a ball juggler and ball cannons! There's also a café adjacent to the soft

play area. Scarf families can arrive from 9am and we will have exclusive use until 10am. After that time members of the public will come in, but families are welcome to stay as long as they like.

**£3 per child (under 3's free)**

**Fri 31<sup>st</sup> May, 9.45am-12.30pm**

**Scarf 2 Wetwheels "Full Experience", Berthon Marina, Bath Road, Lymington, SO41 3YL**

Our Scarf 2 group is for young people with additional needs from Year 11 upwards (age 15/16-25 years) – newcomers are very welcome. Parents/carers do not need to stay as we will have our support workers there to support young people during the session. This is a chance to go out on the Wetwheels boat, which is fully accessible for all, have a cruise up the river, and then a bit of a blast out on the Solent! Everyone will get a chance to have a go at a bit of high-speed driving if they'd like to before returning back to the marina. Young people will need to dress appropriately with plenty of warm clothing, including a warm hat, waterproof jacket and soft shoes. Even on sunny days you may get splashed and it is always colder on the water! We can change afterwards into dry clothes if needed, then we will have some lunch (probably at the marina, tbc). **Fri 31<sup>st</sup> May, 1.45-3.15pm**

**Family Wetwheels "Full Experience", Berthon Marina, Bath Road, Lymington, SO41 3YL**

As well as the Scarf 2 group, we also have a chance for families to go out on the Wetwheels boat, which is fully accessible for all, have a cruise up the river, and then a bit of a blast out on the Solent, possibly out to the Needles depending on the weather! There's room for up to 11 people, and everyone will get a chance to have a go at a bit of high-speed driving if they'd like to before returning back to the marina. Everyone will need to dress appropriately with plenty of warm clothing, including a warm hat, waterproof jacket and soft shoes. Even on sunny days you may get splashed and it is always colder on the water! Bring dry clothes to change into afterwards just in case! - For May half term, we are giving families the first week after the programme is released to put in their choices before places are allocated (to ensure places are allocated fairly rather than first-come-first-served). Further activities can be booked later on if places are available.
- You will receive an email either confirming your places or advising it you are on a waiting list. If you are on the waiting list where activities are over-subscribed you won't need to pay for this activity unless a place becomes available.
- Please pay for your confirmed activities in advance either by bank transfer (preferred method) or posting a cheque by **Fri 24<sup>th</sup> May** at the latest.
