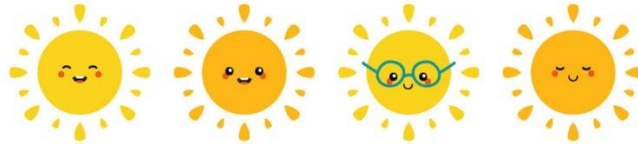




SUMMER PROGRAMME 2024

WEEK 1 – w/c 22nd July

Wed 24th July, 10am-2pm (exact times tbc)

Scarf 2 Forest Bus/Pizza Activity, meet at Lymington Bus Stop

Our **Scarf 2** group is for young people with additional needs from Year 11 upwards (ie: age 16-25 years). Parents/carers do not need to stay for this activity as young people will be supported by Scarf support workers. This activity will combine a circuit on the New Forest Bus Tour with an Italian meal! We plan to meet at the bus stop in Lymington, take the Forest Bus to Lyndhurst on the green route, get off there for a pizza for lunch, then continue on the Forest Bus back to Lymington.

Thurs 25th July, All Day (ferry at 10.30am)

Hurst Castle Activity Day, Hurst Castle Ferry, Keyhaven, SO41 0TP

Spend a day at Hurst Castle with other Scarf families. We have the big ferry leaving from Keyhaven booked at 10.30am, but don't worry if you miss it as you can catch a later ferry. On arrival, feel free to explore the castle. Hurst have arranged for Scarf families to have use of the Garrison Theatre as a base during the day – you can pick up a trail from there to use for exploring the castle, and also there will be activities such as colouring and word searches available! Around 1-2pm Hurst will provide teas/coffees/soft drinks and cakes for Scarf families, so do come along for that. Spend as long as you like at the Castle - there's plenty to explore (both within the castle grounds and the beach outside). You can bring along a picnic or use the café (but savoury items are limited and first-come, first-served to all visitors). There are plenty of indoor places to explore in the Castle if the weather is wet. Take the ferry home whenever it suits you (or you can also walk back along the spit if you're feeling energetic) – the last ferry back is at 5.30pm, and they leave approx every 20 minutes.

Friday 26th July, 6-7.15pm

Lymington Sea Water Baths (1), Bath Road, Lymington, SO41 3RU

We have the Lymington Sea Water baths all to ourselves for an evening of fun in the water. Arrive at 6pm to swim and enjoy all the different inflatables. The paddleboards and other water activities will also be available for children to use. There are lifeguards on duty and pool activities will be open from 6 to 7.15pm (with time to get changed afterwards) and the kiosk will be open all evening selling

hot dogs/burgers, chips, ice cream, tea/coffees, etc. You are also welcome to bring along your own picnic to eat there. Please bring swimming costumes/towels (wetsuits and wetsuit shoes are great if you have them and are also available to hire), and warm clothes for after swimming. Mon 29th July, 11am-12.40pm

Garfield at The Cinema, Lymington Community Centre, New Street, Lymington SO41 9BQ

Scarf have a private viewing of "The Garfield Movie" (PG), which looks great - have a look at the trailer here: https://www.imdb.com/video/vi3877947161/?ref=tt_vi_t_2. The film starts at 11am and lasts around 1 hour 41 minutes. Arrive around 10.45am to take your seats. You can bring your own snacks, but please take your rubbish with you when you leave. Remember parking can be difficult so leave extra time to find a space.

Family Boat Trip, Solent Dolphin (1), Hythe Marina, SO45 6DY

Join us for a boat trip from Hythe Marina on the Solent Dolphin (<https://solentdolphin.co.uk>) with other Scarf families (we also have 2 other dates for this activity – Tues 20th Aug & Tues 27th Aug). This is a fully accessible boat and will take a trip out on the Solent taking in all the sights and spotting all the cruise liners – children will also get a chance to have a go at steering the boat. Teas/coffees available on board! Max 12 people per trip. All children age 14 and younger will need to wear a life jacket during the voyage (they have plenty to choose from on board).

Tues 30th July, 2-3.30pm

Becky's Bakes Cupcakes, Hordle Church Hall, Hordle Lane, Hordle, Lymington, SO41 0FB

We'll be doing a Cupcake Decorating Class with Becky – each child/young person will have 4 of Becky's homemade Cupcakes to work on, and she will give expert guidance and support on how to decorate them including piping them with icing (various techniques), toppings and making some sugar pasting decorations to adorn them. Obviously you can take them home to eat (if you manage to get them home). Children will wear a chef's hat and get a small goodie back to take home. Drinks and teas/coffees available for everyone. The workshop is suitable for varied ages. Aprons are provided on the day.

Puffin "Pirate" Cruise, The Quay, Lymington, SO41 3AT

We're aiming this activity at our younger members – but all are welcome. Enjoy a half hour pirate cruise with Puffin Cruises, from Lymington Quay on "Black Puffin". Take a fun "pirate themed" trip up the river with other Scarf families – there's pirate dressing up clothes on board, toys to play with, bubbles and a chance to drive the boat if you'd like to. Room for 12 passengers at a time - we'll have one group going at 10.30am, then we've also booked for a group to go at 11am, and also 11.30am. Lots to do in Lymington afterwards if you want to make more of a day of it! There's paid parking on the quay and other car parks close by.

Animal Assisted Therapy (1) with Sarah May, Ashley, New Milton, Hants

We have booked 5 sessions with Sarah over the Summer Holidays (other dates are 6th, 12th, 20th and 29th Aug), as there is always a demand for this activity. Children can enjoy spending quality time with Sarah's pets, which include Finley the spaniel (an approved assisted therapy dog), guinea pigs, rabbits and chickens. This will take place outside in Sarah's garden (which has shelter if it rains) and families can spend time meeting and petting the animals in small groups of 6 children. Family Rounders/BBQ at Woodside Gardens, Lymington SO41 8FP

Come and join us for a Scarf family rounders game at Woodside Gardens, followed by a BBQ burger or hot dog (veggie or meat from the local butcher). We'll be based by the sports café, and we'll have a sports coach (Aiden who's worked with our group before) facilitating a rounders game, but he'll also bring along some other sporting equipment if children prefer to do something else. Let us know if you want to order BBQ food and your food choices, otherwise you are welcome to bring along your own food. The café will be open for drinks and other snacks too, or bring your own.

Fri 2nd Aug, 10.30am-12pm (arrival time 10.15am)

Family Caneing, New Forest Activities, Baileys Hard, Beaulieu, SO42 7YF

A family activity having fun out on the Beaulieu River in stable, open Canadian canoes (check out the kayaking activity on Thurs 8th Aug if you prefer to go a bit faster up the river). Enjoy a 90 minute session with lots of time to explore and play on the river (arrival at 10.15am for a briefing, on the water by 10.30am). This activity is suitable for all ages and will be led by qualified instructors. Parents/carers need to go in the canoes with their children, and everyone ready and keen to have a go at paddling (and be prepared to get a bit wet)! Boats can fit 2-4 people (depending on size), and all buoyancy aids will be provided. Wear old clothes and trainers that you don't mind getting wet, waterproofs, and have a towel and change of clothing for afterwards. There are picnic tables at the venue, a water station to refill bottles and the hot drinks station will be open so you can help yourselves to a tea/coffee afterwards.

WEEK 3 - w/c 5th Aug

Mon 5th Aug, 10-11.30am

Bright and Bubbly, St John's Church Hall, St John's Road, Bashley, NM, BH25 5SN

Come along for a session at Bright and Bubbly with Kim. Have a look on their website for more details here: <https://brightandbubbly.co.uk/>. This will involve using the sensory room and sensory garden, they'll be bubbles, animal encounters to enjoy and garden activities – aimed at primary aged children (plus) and those that would enjoy sensory play. Teas/coffees available for parents/carers.

Scarf 2 Motorboats/Lunch, Tucton Boat-hire, 323 Belle Vue Road, Southbourne, BH6 3BA

Our Scarf 2 group is for young people with additional needs from Year 11 upwards (ie: age 16-25 years). Parents/carers do not need to stay for this activity as young people will be supported by Scarf support workers/volunteers. We are hiring some small motorboats and spending an hour on the water, driving up and down the river –this has become an annual favourite! Each boat can take 6 people, and everyone can have a go at steering (max speed is 5 mph!). We will then have a wander along the river, then lunch at Tucton Tea Gardens.

Animal Assisted Therapy (2) with Sarah May, Ashley, New Milton, Hants

This is our 2nd session with Sarah over May Half Term (the other sessions are on 1st Aug, 12th Aug, 20th Aug and 29th Aug) - see above for more details on this activity.

Tues 6th Aug, all day

New Forest Bus Tour, various start points around the New Forest

Enjoy a day out on the buses with the New Forest Bus Tour. Tickets will be emailed out in advance. You can join the bus at any point – there are three different circular routes to choose from and you can change routes at various points too. Wed 7th Aug, 10am-12pm

Ems Friendly Farm + Craft, Boldre War Memorial Hall, Pilley Street, Pilley, Lym, SO41 5QG

We have Ems Friendly Farm visiting us at Boldre War Memorial Hall - they will be bringing 2 goats, 2 sheep, a pig and a Shetland Pony, and be with us from 10am-12pm. Small groups of around 5 children will get to spend time, in approx 15 minute slots, with the animals. Your child may get a second go depending on numbers booked. There will also be a ceramic mug painting craft activity in the hall for children to take part in too, and teas/coffees/soft drinks/biscuits for everyone. We will let you know your farm animals time-slot nearer the time and you can enjoy the craft activity before or after the farm animals. There's also a playground on site.

Thurs 8th Aug, 1-2.30pm (arrival time 12.45pm)

Family Kayaking (sit on top kayaks), New Forest Activities, Baileys Hard, Beaulieu, SO42 7YF

A family activity having fun out on the Beaulieu River using double and single sit-on-top kayaks, which go a bit faster than the Canadian canoes, so suitable for those that may want to go a bit further up the river (see also family canoeing session on 2nd Aug if this suits you better). This will be a 90 minute session with lots of time to explore and play on the river (arrival at 12.45pm to be on the water by 1pm). This activity is for children age 10+ for double kayaks (ideally with a parent or older teenage sibling) and age 12+ for single kayaks, and a parent/carer will need to go on the water in a kayak too. Be prepared to get a bit wet! Buoyancy aids will be provided. Wear old clothes and trainers that you don't mind getting wet, waterproofs, and have a towel and change of clothing for afterwards. There are picnic tables at the venue, a water station to refill bottles and the hot drinks station will be open so you can help yourselves to a tea/coffee afterwards.

£8/person, age 10+ – 16 people

Fri 9th Aug, 10am onwards

Ringos + Alpine Adventure Park, Snowtrax, Matchams Lane, Hurn, Christchurch, BH23 6AW

We have an hour of fun on the ringos at the ski slopes (Snowtrax) from 10-11am. Suitable for children age 5+ and must be over 1m tall (3ft 3"). They have recently installed a new escalator to make getting ringos up the hill much easier. The café should be open for hot/cold drinks. All children will need to wear helmets during the session which can be borrowed, or you can bring your own (cycling or skiing helmets are fine). After the ringos, there's the option to go to the Alpine Adventure Playground too for a run around, and you may want to bring a picnic.

WEEK 4 - w/c 12th Aug

Mon 12th Aug, 10.30am-12pm

Animal Assisted Therapy (3) with Sarah May, Ashley, New Milton, Hants

This is our 3rd session with Sarah over May Half Term (the other sessions are on 1st Aug, 7th Aug, 20th Aug, 29th Aug) - see above for more details on this activity.

£6 per child – 6 children

Mon 12th Aug, 1-3pm (arrive at 12.45)

Surfing Session – Sorted Surf School, The Overstrand, Undercliff Dr, Bournemouth, BH5 1BN (next to Urban Reef Café, close to Boscombe Pier)

As a group you will be having a fun session on the water learning to surf (if the conditions are not good for surfing, bodyboarding or paddleboarding will be on offer depending on the sea state on the day - there will always be something fun to do regardless of the conditions!). The minimum age for this activity is 8 years and children must be able to swim 50m unaided in order to take part (if children are not able to do this, but parents/carers feel they would still be capable of taking part, please let us know so that we can discuss the support needed for your child). All equipment and wetsuits are provided, just bring a towel, swimmers, sun-cream, water and something warm to wear after the lesson. If you have your own wetsuit, it may help to come along wearing it to save time changing. Communal hot showers and changing rooms are next to the surf school. There is ample parking nearby but you may want to arrive in plenty of time to make sure you have a space, especially if it's a nice day. Parents/carers who are strong swimmers can support children in the water.

Tues 13th Aug, 10am-12pm

“Surviving in the Wilderness”, New Park Farm, Lyndhurst Road, Brockenhurst SO42 7QH

Run by the team at Youth Options the theme for the morning will be 'surviving in the wilderness' and the group will have fun learning some basic survival skills such as shelter building, animal tracking, wildlife ID and basic woodworking. There will also be games to play and an opportunity for children to explore the woods more independently too. Once you've finished you're welcome to stay on site to eat a picnic. All ages are welcome. Based in the forest, at New Park Farm, near Brockenhurst

Tues 13th Aug, 6-7.30pm

Evening Cruise to the Needles from Keyhaven, SO41 OTR

Meet at the ferry at Keyhaven for an 1½ hour cruise on the Solent Rose, hopefully to the Needles, but this will depend on the weather on the day. Please arrive by 5.45 for departure at 6pm. There is a pay and display car park opposite The Gun pub (postcode SO41 0TL). This trip is weather dependent and may need to be cancelled at the last minute if the sea is very rough! The boat can accommodate 60 people, bring snacks to keep you going. No toilets on board but there are public toilets at the Keyhaven Car Park.

Wed 14th Aug, 10-11.30 or 11.45-1.15

PEDALL Inclusive Cycling, Burley Yard, Lyndhurst Road (nr Burley village)

We have booked 4 sessions with PEDALL over the summer holidays (the other sessions are on Tues 27th Aug). There will be a whole range of adapted bikes and standard bikes to choose from (including tandems, tricycles, wheelchair cycles, hand-cycles and recumbents). This session will be guided by an Inclusive Cycle Ride Leader from Pedall, and the group will cycle on gravel tracks from the yard - up to around 5km max, but this can be adapted on the day depending on the group and their cycling experience/ability. Parents/carers need to stay with their child/young person on the bike ride - standard bikes will be available for parents/carers/siblings not using a double bike. Everyone will need to dress for the weather and bring water (and a snack if needed). Summer Activity Morning with New Forest Outreach Support, Boldre War Memorial Hall, Pilley Street, Pilley, Lymington SO41 5QG**

We're looking forward to another session with Amy and her team from New Forest Outreach Support, following the success of our first activity with them. We have two sessions for different ages groups (pick the most appropriate group for your family) with similar activities but they will be tailored to suit the different age groups. Amy is planning lots of summer beach party themed activities based outside (weather permitting) including a sand pit for the younger ones, face painting/stick-on tattoos, crafts, bracelet making and hopefully a bouncy castle too. She will bring along Hetty the tortoise and 2 rabbits for petting. George the therapy dog will be coming along to the session too (let me know if your child doesn't like dogs so that we can work around this). Battlezone Laser Tag, Bull's Wood, East Boldre, Hampshire, SO42 7PD

A chance to have a go on the outdoor Battlezone Laser Tag area using fun and lightweight infra-red gaming guns, run by New Forest Activities. Scarf will have sole use of the battlezone area – adults don't need to take part (but you can book up to join in too if you'd like to support your child/young person) – either way parents/carers will need to stay within the area to supervise their child/young person. The instructors will set up a variety of fun and inclusive mini-games tailored to our group. Children need to be age 8 upwards (we may be able to accommodate some 7 year olds too if you think they would be able to manage the games). We have 40 spaces available for this activity. WEEK 5 - w/c 19th Aug

Mon 19th Aug, All day

Swanage Train Trip, park at Purbeck Park next to Norden Station, Sat nav: BH20 5DW

Enjoy a day out in Swanage, starting with a train trip from Norden Station. Park at Purbeck Park (right by Norden Station - £4 for the day). Scarf will supply you with your train tickets for the day, and you can decide how to spend your day. There's plenty to do in the Swanage area, and your ticket will be a return ticket from Norden to Swanage (just a short walk from the beach) and allows for one break in the journey, eg. Corfe Castle. The trains are a mix of steam and diesel train, and the train trip is 6 miles, taking 25 minutes – have a look on the timetable: <https://www.swanagerailway.co.uk/calendar>. The first train from Norden goes at 10.30am (aim to arrive 20 minutes before), and the last train to return from Swanage is 5.10pm. One carer can go free per child with additional needs – the free carer ticket is issued on the day of travel from the booking office and you'll need to bring valid proof of your child's disability (eg. PIP/DLA, or a letter from a consultant or school will also be sufficient). We will not be doing this as a group activity, but hopefully you will bump into other Scarf families on the day.

Family Boat Trip, Solent Dolphin (2), Hythe Marina, SO45 6DY

Run by Emma, a Dramatherapist (who runs Scarf's Drama Club). Parents/carers will need to stay, but not in the room with Emma, but in the café in the adjacent room. You are invited to come along to a creative workshop filled with summer themed sensory play and games. This creative workshop will be a small group and so participants will be able to make new friends, and try new things through imagination and play.

Wed 21st Aug, 10.45am-3pm

Scarf 2 Zip Wire & Archery, Ferny Crofts, Beaulieu Road, Brockenhurst, SO42 7YQ (between Beaulieu and Lyndhurst)

Our **Scarf 2** group is for young people with additional needs from Year 11 upwards (ie: age 16-25 years). Parents/carers do not need to stay for this activity as young people will be supported by Scarf support workers/volunteers. We are visiting Ferny Crofts for the first time. We'll start by doing the zip wire activity (there's a metal staircase to climb inside the tower, before you zip down – if you will struggle with this let us know as a hoist up can be arranged). Everyone will need to wear helmets and harnesses. We'll have an hour's break for lunch, then have an archery session before heading home. Bring along a packed lunch!
