### Slime Making Workshop, River of Life Church, Tiptoe Road, SO41 6FT

Join us for a fun and gooey creative session with Jessica from Creation Station, where Scarf members will make their very own slime! We'll provide everything you need: slime ingredients, colors, glitters, mix-ins, and guidance throughout.

### New Forest Hospital Radio Tour and Presenting Opportunity.

We're excited to be visiting New Forest Hospital Radio for a very special behind-the-scenes guided tour of the radio station. Members will have the opportunity to learn how a real radio show is put together and discover what happens behind the microphone. When your booking is confirmed, you'll be given a 15min time slot for your visit. You'll see the studio, explore the equipment, and find out how presenters broadcast music and messages to patients in hospital. Scarf members will also have the opportunity (if they want to) to record their own short message, introducing themselves and their favourite song. Everyone's recordings will be edited together into a special Scarf requests show to be played out on New Forest Hospital Radio at a later date.

## Tuesday 31st March 10-11:30 and 11:45-1:15pm

### Pedall Inclusive Cycling, Burley Yard, Lyndhurst Road

We have booked 4 sessions with Pedall over the Easter holidays  
(the other sessions are on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> April at 10am and 11:45am).

There will be a whole range of adapted bikes and standard bikes to choose from (including tandems, tricycles, wheelchair cycles, hand-cycles and recumbents). This session will be guided by an Inclusive Cycle Ride Leader from Pedall, and the group will cycle on gravel tracks from the yard - up to around 5km max, but this can be adapted on the day depending on the group and their cycling experience/ability.

Parents/carers need to stay with their child/young person on the bike ride - standard bikes will be available for parents/carers/siblings not using a double bike. Everyone will need to dress for the weather and bring water (and a snack if needed). Here's a link to info about the bikes so you can see what's available:

Working with Emma Kerr, a Dramatherapist, we are running a K-Pop Demon Hunters inspired Dance Workshop for children and young people aged 10+. Together, we'll create an exciting routine inspired by the style and storytelling of K-Pop Demon Hunters, which will be shared with family members at the end of the workshop. The session will focus on creativity, expression, and having fun, with movements adapted to suit all abilities so everyone can take part in a way that feels comfortable and empowering. Throughout the workshop there will be opportunities to play inclusive games, build confidence, and share favourite K-Pop inspired moves with each other. Participants are encouraged to join in at their own pace, with plenty of support and encouragement along the way.

Scarf have the pool and rapids all to ourselves for this private session (for up to 100 swimmers). There will be floats and rings available, and you can take a pirate wash under the tipping bucket, climb up to the crows nest and whizz down the long slide, enjoy the rapids and relax in the Jacuzzi. For younger ones there is a pirate ship and a toddler slide in the toddler pool area. Please arrive at 5pm to register with the Scarf Meet and Greet and change beforehand - come as swim ready as you can be as we are only allowed into the changing rooms at 5pm.

We have the changing rooms afterwards for 15 minutes. Swimmers over 8 years old do not need to be accompanied by an adult swimming with them. One adult may accompany two children under 8. Both children must be supervised in all areas. Under 4's and non-swimmers must be supervised on a 1-1 basis and must wear floatation aids. Bring a £1 coin for the changing lockers.

Ashley Family Hub, Normans Way, New Milton BH25 5FN


